During the last IUCr Congress in Prague, a discussion has been launched within GIG₃ on the policy of inclusion and diversity that should be promoted by the European Crystallographic Association. As a result, a letter has been prepared and signed by some of the members of GIG₃ and has been sent to the ECA President and to the Executive Committee. The aim of this letter is to contribute to draft ECA guidelines concerning diversity and inclusiveness.

GIG₃, in collaboration with DECTRIS and STOE, is coordinating a fundraising project that will take place during ECM₃₃, for the support of female crystallographers, especially for emerging countries.

GIG₃ has continued to pursue its former activities: the dedicated website is being constantly developed with the inputs of ECA members. The website proposes to collect and highlight national and international events on education, as well as links to educational websites, papers and books.

GIG₃ is involved in the organization of the seventh European school in Portugal. Moreover, support from the GIG₃ have been sought by the organizers of different educational activities which will take place in Europe and in extra-European countries.

The involvement of GIG3 in the ECM33 resulted in the co-organization of three Microsymposia (see point 6)
