## Meeting of GIG-SC on the 25th August 2015 at 12h00 in Rovinj, Croatia

The chair of the GIG-SC, Svend-Erik Rasmussen, present in Rovinj, announced a very short time before the meeting that he was unable to attend. As a consequence, the meeting was chaired by Carlo Mealli and Howard Flack. These concise minutes of the meeting have been compiled by Howard Flack.

As Svend-Erik Rasmussen was not present, no summary of the activity report 2014-2015 was presented to the meeting. The <u>written document</u> had however been available prior to the meeting on the GIG-SC's website.

The meeting proceeded to the election of the officers of the GIG-SC. The meeting respected the wish of Svend-Erik Rasmussen and Theo Hahn not to stand for reelection. Paul Beurskens was considered not to be a candidate to his own reelection. Howard Flack, Carlo Mealli and Helen Stoeckli-Evans were accepted as candidates to their own re-election. There followed a pleasant and exquisite period of discussion, negotiation and persuasion. At the vote, the meeting unanimously elected the following six persons to the committee:

The meeting considered the proposition of statutes for the GIG-SC. These had been attached to the agenda paper and displayed on the website of the GIG-SC prior to the meeting. Some printed copies were available at the meeting. After a short discussion, the statutes were accepted unanimously by the meeting.

The meeting gave consideration to the opportunity for senior crystallographers to publish open access papers. The discussion also covered the area of access to crystallographic databases. The essence of the problem is one of payment for these services. Some senior crystallographers continue to work but have no funding for such activities.

It was stated that at present the IUCr has no official policy on this topic. Cases are dealt with on an individual basis. If a senior crystallographer wishes a paper to be made open access but has no funding, it is best to write to the co-editor or editor of the journal being used. The question was asked whether there was a real problem, as most institutions now have package contracts with journal providers. Others present stated that physical separation from the home institution or the lack of any formal tie with an institution made access to journal publications problematic. Open access publications were much appreciated in such cases.

The situation with respect to access to crystallographic databases for senior crystallographers was similar. Carlo Mealli stated that he had had informal contacts with the CCDC who said that they would investigate the case of senior crystallographers. No contact has yet been undertaken with other providers of crystallographic databases.
