SPECIAL INTEREST GROUP FOR CRYSTALLOGRAPHIC COMPUTING (SIG-9)

During 2024 there were no changes in the board of SIG-9.

For the ECM35 congress in Poznan/Lviv our SIG has proposed topics and speakers for microsymposia and keynotes. Michal Chodkiewicz was our representative in the program committee. For the next ECM, ECM36 in Prague, our representative will be Jan Rohlicek.

For the first time after the corona pandemic, SIG-9 is able to organize a Software Fayre at ECM35. This will take place during the lunch breaks and is accessible for all congress participants. Authors of crystallographic software will demonstrate their programs. All time slots were easily filled.

Also for the first time after the pandemic, we will again have a Computing Forum as a satellite to the main congress. The forum is on 22-24 Aug 2025 in Poznan. The main input to the scientific program will be from the participants themselves. They will present their own efforts and challenges. There will be enough time for programming sessions in small groups. We expect ca. 32 participants (incl. organizers). The Computing Forum is thus fully booked.
